- Signage or other printed materials to contribute to community appeal;
- Costs associated with beautification projects;
- Necessary products to effectively conduct a community action project.

Note: Costs must relate directly to community action activities. The eligible costs are intentionally broad to meet the unique needs of communities throughout our region.

The following points will be considered when evaluating grant applications:

- The proposed project will make an impact on the community.
- The degree to which funding is utilized to address needs throughout the community.
- If cooperative efforts through a public/private partnership are used to implement and maintain the project.
- Likelihood of the project being implemented in a timely manner.
