1. Call Meeting to Order

With the increase in funding Brian highlighted the importance of determining projects to be added to the needs list. Brian reported MoDOT is working to improve the conditions of minor roads and bridges and he will be distributing a map of routes in the region averaging over 400 cars a day.

The 2021 Mark Twain COG TAC Road and Bridge Needs Ranking was reviewed and discussed. No changes were made to the needs ranking list, but it was noted that the counties should identifying 5 to 7 more projects to add to the list by the June meeting.
