### Mark Twain Regional Council of Governments Shop Local Campaign Grant Information

The Mark Twain Regional Council of Governments (MTRCOG) is offering grants of up to \$2,000 for shop local campaigns. Campaigns must be implemented within Audrain, Macon, Marion, Monroe, Pike, Ralls, Randolph, and Shelby counties in Missouri. Only organizations located in the MTRCOG region are eligible to apply and only one application from each city will be funded.

#### Eligible costs include but are not limited to:

- Campaign promotional products;
- Signage or other printed materials for shop local initiatives;
- Costs associated with hosting a shop local campaign event;
- Necessary products to facilitate shop local campaigns.

Note: Costs must relate directly to shop local initiatives. Only purchases made after grant approval will be eligible for reimbursement.

## The following items will be considered when evaluating grant applications:

- The proposed campaign addresses shop local initiatives.
- The degree to which shop local campaigns are used to promote local business and/or increase participation in shop local practices.
- If cooperative efforts through a public/private partnership are used to implement and maintain the project.
- Likelihood of the project being implemented in a timely manner.
