WHEREAS, **Audrain County** has participated in the preparation of a Audrain County multi-jurisdictional local hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the **MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**, hereafter referred to as the *Plan*, in accordance with the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the *Plan* identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the **Audrain County** from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, **Audrain County** recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, **Audrain County** will endeavor to integrate the *Plan* into the comprehensive planning process; and

WHEREAS, adoption by **Audrain County** demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Plan*.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF VANDALIA, MISSOURI that all aspects pertaining to the City of Vandalia, in the Audrain County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan attached hereto, and incorporated by reference herein, shall be monitored, evaluated, updated and resubmitted to this governing body for re-adoption periodically (at least) every five years from the date of the last adoption, by the Board of Aldermen.


This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.


WHEREAS adoption by the City of Mexico, Missouri demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:




